- Interest in supervising master and PhD students

The Unit Molecular Epidemiology runs various national and international studies with a focus on cancer, metabolic and other chronic disorders and investigates the role of biological markers including microbiomics, metabolomics, genetics and epigenetics in its etiological research. The unit is engaged in various research consortia like the German National Cohort (GNC), the International Head & Neck Cancer Epidemiology Consortium (INHANCE) and the European IDEFICS/I.Family cohort and it collaborates closely with the biobank at our institute as well as with the other units and departments of BIPS.

Requirements
