Title PhD openings in NanoBioTechnology

Institution The Center for NanoScience (CeNS) was founded in 1998 at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University (LMU) Munich. The mission of CeNS is to promote and coordinate interdisciplinary research in the field of nanoscience in the Munich area. CeNS is an association of junior and senior scientists from basic research and industry and is conceived as a network, joining people from various institutions (LMU, TU Munich, University of Augsburg and others).

Position The doctorate program of CeNS offers 14 doctoral positions for outstanding graduate students, starting between May and October 2012. Successful candidates will work in the stimulating interdisciplinary environment of CeNS. The PhD students will be supervised by principal investigators of CeNS and will be affiliated with the Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich (LMU). The recommended duration of the PhD is 3 years.

- Bachelor Degree (or equivalent, e.g. Vordiplom) in either the field of physics, chemistry or life sciences
- either prepare for a Master Degree (or equivalent, e.g. Diplom) in one of the same fields to be concluded no later than 2 months before the start of the scholarship or hold a Master Degree (or equivalent, e.g. Diplom)
- excellent grades
- a very good command of the English language
- strong scientific motivation
- interest in the activities of CeNS
- interest in interdisciplinary research
