4. Position, scientific requirements, topic, discipline*:

The MEDIAN Klinik Berlin-Kladow is a rehabilitation center for neurology and orthopedics, associated to the Charité. Its interdisciplinary research department consists of physicians, psychologists, occupational therapist and physiotherapists. For technical developments, we are closely collaborating with technical professions, mainly at the Berlin Technical University. Our main focus is the evaluation and improvement of therapies in neurorehabilitation. For this, we systematically assess existing therapies and develop and evaluate new ones. Clinical studies in patients are complemented by imaging studies (fMRI, fNIRS) in order to understand the underlying neural mechanisms

Interested post-docs should have experience either in imaging techniques or clinical research. Readiness for integration into an interdisciplinary team is essential. For clinical work, proficiency of German is beneficial.
