Title High Potentials Grant

Institution University Medical Center of Johannes Gutenberg-University Mainz (<https://www.unimedizin-mainz.de/index.html>)

Position We offer a funding program for outstanding post-doctoral scientists (clinician scientists or natural scientists) from Germany and abroad, who will be given the opportunity to establish themselves as independent researchers with their own research profile at the University Medical Center (UMC) Mainz.

Successful candidates will be employed at the UMC. A funding of €100,000 p.a. to finance their own position and further project costs will be available to the candidates for a duration of 3 years. Clinician scientists who, due to their clinical obligations, only apply for funding of their proportionate employment (at least 50%) by these means can apply for a cost-neutral extension of the funding period to a maximum of 4 years.

Responsibilities During the grant, candidates are expected to acquire significant third-party funding.

Requirements This grant is intended for outstanding post-doctoral scientists who have already distinguished themselves with high-ranking publications, their own third-party funding and proven their potential as independent scientists.

Application procedure (deadline etc.) The application process has two stages. Direct applications are not accepted. Candidates are nominated by potential mentors from the UMC. If you are an outstanding post-doctoral researcher who fits the profile and are looking for a possibility to establish yourself as an independent researcher at the UMC – approach a suitable

mentor at one of the many excellent clinics/institutes of the UMC to discuss the possibility of being nominated for this grant (<https://www.unimedizin-mainz.de/index.html>).

The Committee for Research Support (AFF) makes the decision on inviting full proposals and awarding the High Potentials Grant.

Please pay attention to the rules concerning unconscious biases towards gender and origin in the application procedure.

For the first stage of the application process, the required documents must be sent electronically to prodekan-forschung.um@uni-mainz.de by October 10, 2021.
