**5. Project idea/position (scientific requirements, topic, discipline):**

Rough outline of idea/position:

To protect nature, to harmonize human uses and to enable sustainable development in coastal seas, the European Union launched a wide spectrum of integrative and innovative policies. However, the last decade has shown that policy implementation is largely hampered, that environmental objectives will not be reached, or that measures turned out to be insufficient and ineffective. Further, the implementation of new ideas or adaptation measures are time-consuming and often delayed. New ideas, approaches, measures and tools are needed to re-vitalize policy implementation and to enable a development towards a healthy and sustainably used coastal and marine environment.

Aim is the further-development and test of computer aided management tools (e.g. for ecosystem service assessment, stakeholder participation, scenario development, indicator-based evaluation or cost-effectiveness assessments) for managing coastal seas and supporting coastal and marine policy implementation.
